

Getsoccer Roster and Player Accounts

Getsoccer is the premier tournament and league management system on the market used by hundreds of Tournaments and Leagues. It is also the best known ranking and college recruiting system.

Getsoccer Team Account

There is a very high probability that pretty much any team during its lifetime will get a getsoccer account. **It is very important that you use the same account to apply to all the getsoccer managed events.** Creating new team accounts will lead to spreading the team's results/history/ranking points across them and duplicating efforts to update rosters. Getsoccer offers team accounts mergers but they charge \$25 for the service.

Getsoccer Roster

To update your team roster in your getsoccer team account, login and click on Roster. Click on 'Add New Player' and complete the minimum required information - Name, gender, birth date AND email address. Click on Save and the player is added to the team roster. Make sure the birth dates you enter are correct since getsoccer software determines the team age based on the age of the oldest player on the roster.

How to add guest players to your team roster

Team managers/coaches are tempted to create a new player account for a guest player. The right way to do it is to have the tournament director open the tournament to guest players and for the players who want to guest to register as guests. Once that happens, the manager/coach can login the team account, click on the Event and on Guests and pull those players on the team roster for that specific event.

Roster event management

Some teams have an extended Master Roster (Primary Player List) and they participate in events using subsets of it. Since most of the getsoccer managed events print the roster on the game cards, it is very useful to limit this printout to the players who actually participate. You can exclude players from events by clicking on the name, on the Event Attendance tab and Remove that player from any event the team participates in.

Getsoccer Player Account

When you add a player to your roster an account is created for that player. The email address is used to not only identify this account and any possibly duplicate accounts, but also provide that player with their username and password.

The player will automatically get an email that looks like this:

Your Team manager or Coach has created an online Player Profile for you which will be viewed by College Coaches using the GotSoccer system. You can edit and add to the profile.

You can change your password once in the administration page of your profile.

The player's email address is accessible only to the College Coaches who are using getsoccer to look for players to recruit. My daughter used it and she never got a spam email.

Some coaches/managers do not feel comfortable providing the player's email address.

In that case, enter a fake email and after you added the player, edit the entry (by clicking on the name), click on Account Info and assign an ID and PW. Pass this info to the player and (s)he can access his/her account to update it with as much info as (s)he wants.

Players interested in playing in College can and should use their accounts free features to create profiles, load video clips, etc. There are nice features that, if used properly, can flag the player to the College Coaches when they run searches through the database.

A player can login his/her player account from the getsoccer home webpage.
